Refer to this guide as a starting point for creating the color you want.

The colors and number of drops in the illustrations are approximate and are to be used as guides only.

It is best to begin with a few drops at a time of any color and to stir well after each addition, remembering that each shade will deepen as it dries.

Note that the Red is beet and appears in hues of pink. Use the beet Red to blend with Yellow for Orange or with Blue for Purple. If you add a bit of Yellow to the beet Red the hue will shift from pink to a more traditional Christmas Red.

Colors will vary depending on the icing recipe used. We have created both a creamed frosting and a royal icing recipe intended to give you the best results.

Pink - 1/8 cup frosting (1 oz) Drops: 3 Red



Red Pink - 1/8 cup frosting (1 oz) Drops: 18 Red, 3 Yellow



Red - 1/8 cup frosting (1 oz) Drops: 28 Red, 6 Yellow



Red Orange - 1/8 cup frosting (1 oz) Drops: 11 Red, 8 Yellow



Orange - 1/8 cup frosting (1 oz) Drops: 20 Yellow, 6 Red



Orange Yellow - 1/8 cup frosting (1 oz) Drops: 16 Yellow, 4 Red



Yellow - 1/8 cup frosting (1 oz) Drops: 12 Yellow



Yellow Green - 1/8 cup frosting (1 oz) Drops: 12 Yellow, 3 Blue



Green - 1/8 cup frosting (1 oz) Drops: 10 Blue, 4 Yellow



Green Blue - 1/8 cup frosting (1 oz) Drops: 4 Blue, 1 Yellow



Blue - 1/8 cup frosting (1 oz) Drops: 10 Blue



Blue Violet- 1/8 cup frosting (1 oz) Drops: 6 Blue, 1 Red



Violet - 1/8 cup frosting (1 oz) Drops: 12 Blue, 4 Red



Violet Pink - 1/8 cup frosting (1 oz) Drops: 3 Red, 2 Blue
